In A/UX 2.0, ls -F should display the current directory's content appending $^{\star}$ , /, @, to denote executable, directory, and symbolic link.
I linked a directory to another symbolic link, but when I typed in ls -F, I see xxx/ rather than xxx@. Although when I typed in ls -1, I can see the symbolic linked directory is linked -> to another directory.
