A/UX 3.0: Centris 610/650 (6/93)

TOPIC -----

I have A/UX 3.0 and just got a Centris 610 8/230/CD. I want to load A/UX on it instead of on my Macintosh IIfx, but I can't install it successfully. Also, can A/UX run from an external drive?

DISCUSSION -----

A/UX 3.0 does not support the Centris 610, Centris 650, or Quadra 800. However, the more recent release of A/UX, A/UX 3.0.1, supports the Centris 650 and Quadra 800. The Centris 610 lacks an FPU and, therefore, cannot run A/UX (unless there is a FPU upgrade solution from a third party).

Yes, you can install A/UX on an external drive with a supported Macintosh computer like the IIfx and be able to move the installed A/UX drive from one supported machine to another supported machine. A/UX automatically configures and rebuilds a new kernel when it finds a hardware change like a new Ethernet NB card.
