A/UX: How to Print a List of Exported File Systems

TOPIC -----

How do I print a list of exported file systems?

DISCUSSION -----

By using the "-e" option with the `/usr/etc/showmount` command, you can quickly list the directories you have exported to other systems on the network.

Example output from the command line "`showmount -e`" executed the command line from the system "`my_system_name`":

```
export list for my_system_name:
/users      machen redpony
/           machen redpony
```

This example says that the directories `/` and `/users` are exported to the systems `machen` and `redpony` only.

In A/UX 3.0, `/etc/exportfs` can be used. With no options, all exported file systems are listed.
