TOPIC -----

I am trying to maximize free space on my A/UX root file system with tunefs, but the changes do not stay in effect as they should after re-booting.

I enter

```
tunefs -m 0 -o space /dev/dsk/c0d0s0
```

Then, I can check and see the new values with

```
tunefs -p /dev/dsk/c0d0s0
```

Any suggestions?

You have found a known problem with tunefs(1). We have a patch for the program available on the A/UX patch server (aux.support.apple.com) which can be downloaded via the Internet using anonymous ftp or by dialing into one of the V.32 Telebit modems and transferring the patch via Kermit, XModem, or the like.
