## A/UX 3.0: libPW.a and Missing Error Symbol (2/93)

TOPIC
I am trying to compile a C application that is using a standard library, included in A/UX 3.0, called libPW.a. I can't find in the library the symbol called Error. Is it missing?
If the Error symbol isn't missing, where is it? Any ideas to compile my application correctly?
DISCUSSION
We have searched in the libPW.a library: the 'Error' symbol is referenced by the modules xcreat.o, xlink.o, xmsg.o, and xopen.o that are defined in the libPW.a archived library. Try 'nm /lib/libPW.a   more'. You'll find where the 'Error' is located.
In order to call any function included in the libPW.a library, besides including the -lPW option to the compiler, make sure that the header file called macros.h in /usr/include is included in the user's program (with the line of #include <macros.h> ). The external Error symbol is declared in macros.h.  Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.</macros.h>
