MacTerminal: Macintosh-to-UNIX File Transfer

TOPIC -----

We have a Motorola 147 microcomputer system running UNIX 568, release 5, version 6. We would like to use some Macintosh Plus or SE computers as terminals and need to know if there is something that will work with MacTerminal or some other emulator to allow file transfers between the computers.

DISCUSSION -----

See if your UNIX host has one of the standard file transfer protocols such as Xmodem, Kermit, or FTP. Most UNIX systems have support for file transfer using these protocols. MacTerminal 3.0 comes with an XMODEM Tool for file transfer. Other terminal emulators such as PacerTerm or VersaTerm-Pro provide other file transfer Tools such as PacerFT, and VersaTerm FTP Tool.
