

X11: Launching on a Workgroup Server 95 (7/94)

TOPIC -----

I am trying to launch X11, and am having some difficulty. I have an Apple Workgroup Server 95 (AWS 95) with A/UX 3.1 configured as FileServer. In this situation I don't have the "Change Session Type.." from the Options menu in the A/UX Login Dialog window.

I have only two possibilities:

- 1) Start the AWS 95 and stop to MacPartition, but in the MacPartition CommandShell I can write Unix commands but NOT launch X11.
- 2) Boot A/UX, but automatically have the system launch "Macgetty", so after launching A/UX, I'm in A/UX Finder environment.

IF I Want to launch X11, I must exit from the A/UX Finder environment, is that Correct? If so, how do I do this?

I have tried with the 'Logout" command from the menu "special" under A/UX Finder environment, but the system appears to exit and then return to A/UX Finder environment.

DISCUSSION -----

Yes, it is correct that you MUST exit from A/UX Finder environment to launch X11.

One flexible way to do this is as follows:

1) Change Session Type to "Console Emulator"

2) Within Console Emulator window, you may execute the command below to get into A/UX Finder environment:

mac32; screenrestore

3) When you want to execute X11, you choose "Logout" from the "Special" menu. It will bring you to the Console Emulator mode.

4) Within the Console Emulator mode, you may type "X11" to get into the X11

Window Systems environment. To get out of the X11 Window environment, type "exit" from the X Console window. This brings you back to the Console Emulator.
