

Apple IIGS: Error 0C Indicates Sound Chip Problem

TOPIC
My Apple IIGS (rev. 03 ROM) gives a self test error code of 0C000004, though everything seems to be working fine. What does this code mean?
DISCUSSION
Apple IIGS Tech Note #95 explains the diagnostics test:
AA = 0C DD = 01: RAM data error 02: RAM address error 03: Data register failed 04: Control register failed 05: Oscillator interrupt timeout
In your case, the problem is a control register failure, specifically a bad sound chip. Since the sound chip is not socketed, you will have to replace the logic board of the Apple IIGS. Copyright 1991 Apple Computer, Inc.
