Apple IIe/IIC

With the mouse card in slot four of the Apple IIe, locations are stored as follows:

- low byte x    \$047C
- high byte x   \$057C
- low byte y    \$04FC
- high byte y   \$05FC

(This is different if the card is in a slot other than slot four.)
