

Applesoft: VAL(A\$) problems

Applesoft running in a non-disk drive system won't initialize its memory properly, resulting in the following program not giving the desired results.

100 GET A\$
110 PRINT A\$, VAL(A\$)

If you input "1" the answer will be "1, 1.11111111E16". A "HIMEM:" statement resets the pointer:

16K HIMEM: 16384 32K HIMEM: 32768 48K HIMEM: 49152 Apple Tech Notes
