

## FORTRAN: Sending Compiler Listings to the Console

While an asterisk (\*) specifies the console under Apple FORTRAN, FORTRAN I/O operations take place within the Pascal operating system, where the asterisk has an entirely different use.

DO NOT TYPE AN ASTERISK (\*) in response to the "LISTING?" prompt when using the FORTRAN compiler. Otherwise, the system will appear to compile, then damage you FORTRAN 2 diskette, severely crippling the operating system.

Type "CONSOLE" to display the listing on your video monitor. Apple Technical Communications
