

Business BASIC III: Print Using

The string specification in Print Using takes only as many characters of a long string as are required to fill its field length; hence, the rest of the string is ignored. This example:

A\$ = "abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz"
Print Using "3X,10A,3X";A\$

returns:

abcdefghij

A\$ is truncated to 10 characters. Use the MID\$ function to split up a string into multiple lines. Apple Tech Notes
