AppleShare Print Server: Hiding the Chooser's Non-Spool Listing

TOPIC -----

I leave AppleShare Print Server (version 2.0 or 3.0) running 24 hours a day and have a LaserWriter captured -- bypass disabled, so that users see the Print Server entry in the Chooser, but not the print-direct entry.

At night, I turn off the LaserWriter. In the morning, when I turn on the LaserWriter, both the LaserWriter and the spooler version of the LaserWriter appear in the Chooser. Should this happen?

DISCUSSION -----

This a known problem, and there are two ways to correct it:

- Release the printer and recapture it.
- Send a print job to the LaserWriter through the spooler.

Printing directly to the LaserWriter does not remove the direct Chooser listing.
