AppleShare 3.0, 3.0.1: Copying Locked files on Server (4/94)

TOPIC -----

If I try to duplicate a locked file with AppleShare 3.0 File Server running, I get the message: "The file 'filename' couldn't be written, because you do not have enough access privileges. Do you want to continue copying?"

DISCUSSION -----

This is an issue. The workarounds are:

- Unlock the file from either the Privileges menu in the Admin application, or the Get Info window in the finder.
- Duplicate from a workstation.
- Shut down the AppleShare server.
