| If I try to duplicate a locked file with AppleShare 3.0 File Server running, I get the message: "The file 'filename' couldn't be written, because you do not have enough access privileges. Do you want to continue copying?" |
| DISCUSSION |
| This is an issue. The workarounds are: |
| • Unlock the file from either the Privileges menu in the Admin application, or the Get Info window in the finder. |
| • Duplicate from a workstation. |
| • Shut down the AppleShare server. |
