AppleShare 3.0: Installing Over the Network

The AppleShare 3.0 Administrator's Guide, on page 161, says to do a live install from either a System 7 or a System 6 computer. After telling the Installer which files I'll need and clicking on the Install button, I get this error message: "The files needed for this installation could not be found on your server volume 'server name'. Please contact your network administrator."

DISCUSSION -----

A live installation can actually be done, but there's an error in the manual. It says to name the workstation software folder on the server "AppleShare". The Installer is looking for an "AppleShare Workstation" folder or disk and can't complete the installation. Please rename the folder "AppleShare Workstation".
