

AppleShare 3.0: How to Remove and Return to System 7

TOPIC
How do I remove AppleShare 3.0 from my Macintosh and return it to System 7?
DISCUSSION
1) Remove the Users & Groups data file from the Preferences folder and restart.
2) Insert the AppleShare File Server disk in the drive and double-click the Installer.
 3) Choose Customize. 4) Select items to remove. You can remove these individually or all at once depending on which you select:
 AppleShare File Server (v3.0) AppleShare Print Server (v3.0) Apple II Setup (v2.1.3) AppleShare Workstation (v3.0)
5) Hold down the Option key, and when the Install button becomes the REMOVE button, click on it.6) Postart the computer
 7) Restart the computer. 7) The system creates a new Users & Groups data file. If you want to return to the data file you used before installing AppleShare 3.0, copy the original System 7 data file to the Preferences folder from a backup (the AppleShare 3.0 Users & Groups data file won't work).
Here's a list of the files automatically removed:
 AppleShare File Server AppleShare Print Server File Server Extension IWEm
There are three other files that aren't removed that you can remove

• AppleShare Log (loose in System Folder)
