| TOPIC |
| I have a question about the installation of the new Client software for AppleShare 3.0. Does the Installer actually install any resources INTO the System file or into any other file? |
| DISCUSSION |
| In general the only thing that happens during the installation of the AppleShare 3.0 workstation software is that the AppleShare file is copied into the Extensions folder. However, if the system has been updated from a version of system software prior to 6.0.3 and hasn't had AppleShare workstation software installed, it's necessary to update some of the AppleTalk files. |
| The recommendation is that if you fit these criteria, go ahead and use the drag install. If problems arise on that workstation, use the Installer provided. |
