

AppleShare Client Software Compatible With System 6.0.x (7/93)

TOPIC -----

I'm trying to make a bootable 800K floppy for my Macintosh Plus that has system 6.0.x and AppleShare client software so I can mount my file server.

AppleShare appears to be working fine until I get to the point of selecting the volume I want to mount. I get the message about the desktop file on the volume needing repair. When I click on "ok" to repair it, I get into a loop with the dialog box saying the desktop file couldn't be created and then there's nothing I can do but reboot.

I am using System 6.0.7 from the Disk Tools disk and tried it with AppleShare from System 7.0.1. What's going wrong?

DISCUSSION -----

There is a compatibility problem when using System 7.0.x version of the AppleShare client software with System 6.0.x. System 7.0.x AppleShare client software should only be used on System 7.0.x systems.

System 7.1 AppleShare client extension and AppleShare 3.0.x client extension are compatible with System 6.0.x. The installer disks should be used to install one of these versions onto a 6.0.x system. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
