System 7.0.x AppleShare Client and System 6.0.x: Incompatible

TOPIC -----

I'm trying to make a bootable 800K floppy disk for my Macintosh Plus that has system 6.0.x and AppleShare client software on it so I can mount my file server. AppleShare appears to be working fine until I get to the point of selecting the volume I want to mount. I get a message about the desktop file on the volume needing repair. When I click on OK to repair it, I get into a loop with the dialog box saying the desktop file couldn't be created and then there's nothing I can do but reboot. What's going on?

DISCUSSION -----

This problem stems from the incompatibility of the System 7.0.x version of the AppleShare client software with System 6.0.x. The System 7.0 and System 7.0.1 AppleShare client extension is compatible with System 7.0 and System 7.0.1 only.

With System 6.0.x, you can use the version of AppleShare that comes on the AppleShare 3.0.x Workstation Installer disk, or the System 7.1 version of AppleShare. We recommend using the Installers to install the AppleShare client software on System 6.0.x.

You can also use the Installer from System 6.0.x to install the System 6.0.x version of AppleShare workstation software.
