It is stated that AppleShare Pro can support a maximum of 200 simultaneous users. Is there a limit as to how many user ACCOUNTS can be defined under AppleShare Pro?

DISCUSSION -----

On page 115 of the "AppleShare Pro Administrator's Guide" you will find the AppleShare Pro Specifications appendix.

Here is the contents of that page regarding the AppleShare Pro File Server:

Maximum connected users	200
Maximum number of open files	5,000 (may require adding RAM)
Maximum number of volumes	50
Maximum number of shared items	50
Maximum number of users in a user/group file	2,000 (Recommended)
Maximum number of groups in a user/group file	2,000 (Recommended)
Maximum number of group memberships per user	42
Maximum number of simultaneous launches	200

NOTE: The maximum number of users in a user/group file and maximum number of groups in a user/group file in the manual is stated at 2,000. However, AppleShare Pro is based on AppleShare 4.0 code and the maximum number of users in a user/group file and maximum number of groups in a user/group file in the "AppleShare Administrator's Guide, Version 4" is stated as 8,192 (2,000 recommended).
