| There should be no incompatibilities between various versions of AppleTalk. It's important to know that AppleTalk phase 2 was introduced with AppleTalk version 53. |
| AppleTalk version 56 introduced many bug fixes and should be the minimum version in use on any network with highly utilized servers or routers.
