This article describes the SNA•ps 5250 system requirements, related products, product support, and ordering information.

DISCUSSION -----

To use SNA•ps 5250, you need

- A Macintosh II or Macintosh Quadra computer (NuBus capable)
- An Apple Token Ring 4/16 NB Card or Apple Serial NB Card
- Macintosh system software version 7.0 or later

To use SNA•ps 5250 as a client to an SNA•ps Gateway, you need

- SNA•ps 5250 or SNA•ps 5250 GC
- A Macintosh Plus or later Macintosh system as the client computer
- A Macintosh II or Macintosh Quadra computer running the SNA•ps Gateway software on your AppleTalk network
- Macintosh system software version 7.0 or later

To perform SQL data access on the AS/400

Through SNA•ps APPC sessions, you must have the following software:

- Data Access Language (DAL) Server for AS/400 software (either a 1/4-inch cartridge tape or a 1600 bpi 9-track tape) that provides Macintosh client access to AS/400 databases.
- Data Access Language Client version 1.3.7 software, systems software for the Macintosh computer that provides access to host data for local applications.
