We have the Macintosh Application Environment (MAE) Trial CD and we're trying to run Apple's Macintosh Common Lisp (MCL) environment with it. We're getting an Error 3 illegal instruction error. Can this be tested for verification, and if you find a work around to get it running, could you let us know?

DISCUSSION -----

The Apple MCL environment has been found to be incompatible with MAE version 1.0, primarily due to the absence of Floating Point Unit support.
