Express Modem and Cellular Phone With No Dial Tone CCL (8/93)

TOPIC -----

I can't dial out with a cellular phone with my Express Modem in a PowerBook Duo. I have the appropriate hardware needed with a data jack, but I need help rewriting the CCL to work with no dial tone (NDT). What do I need to do?

DISCUSSION -----

In order to disable dial tone detection use the Xn command in the dialing command. For example ATX3DT 18005551212. X0, X1, and X3 are the commands to use for blind dialing (no dial tone needed). The difference in the three commands is the result codes that they enable. The description of the result codes and the Xn command is documented in the Express Modem AT Commands file that comes with the Express Modem Software.
