In AppleLink, in the Modem string field, I am attempting to put in the Xn codes to disable the dial tone detection. I have tried X0, X1, X2, X3, X4, and none of them have worked. |
| DISCUSSION  |
| The Express Modem CCL ignores the Modem String field within AppleLink's Setup Connection.   |
| All changes to AT commands need to be made within the Express Modem CCL itself. The easiest way to edit the Express Modem CCL (assuming it has already been selected via Setup Connection) is to press the Command, Option and E keys while in AppleLink.   |
| To enable blind dialing, X4 needs to be changed to X3 in Label 6.   |
