GeoPort 2.0 Floppy Installer: Disk 1 or Disk 1/AV (4/95)

TOPIC -----

When installing the GeoPort 2.0 software from floppies, what is the difference between Disk 1 and Disk 1/AV, they both look the same?

Also what happens if I run the non-AV installer on a computer with GeoPort already installed?

DISCUSSION -----

The installer for the GeoPort software behaves differently depending on the disk set you have, and the computer you use.

- Disk 1/AV Installer will work properly on Quadra 660AV and 840AV computers, with or without GeoPort 1.x installed. This disk is NOT recommended for Power Macintosh computers.

- Disk 1 Installer is recommended on Power Macintosh computers, and if you use this disk on a Quadra 660AV or 840AV computer, GeoPort 1.x must be installed.

If you install the GeoPort 2.0 software with the Disk 1 on a Quadra 660AV or 840AV, it will check to see if an earlier version of GeoPort software is already installed. This is due to a licensing agreement. If the Quadra AV-type computer does not have GeoPort 1.x installed, as can happen after a clean install, it will require you to install GeoPort 1.x before you install GeoPort 2.0.

Power Macintosh computers and Express Modems do not have this limitation.

Both disks will install all the Express Modem software for a Quadra 630, LC 575, or PowerBook.
