1) Can a Macintosh print to a Novell Netware queue that is configured f an Epson LQ-1050 or EX-1000 printer?	01
2) What are the steps necessary to do this?	
DISCUSSION	
 Yes, it is possible to print to an Epson LQ-1050 or EX-1000 via a Novell Netware queue. In order to do this, you need a Macintosh driv for the printers. GDT SoftWorks currently sells a package called PowerPrint NW, which has the drivers needed for the printers you hav asked about. 	
2) The PowerPrint NW package will go into details concerning setting up their drivers to work with Novell Netware. The general steps are as follows:	
1) Set up the printer and queue in Novell Netware as per the Novell Netware documentation.	
2) Add the following line to the "atps.cfg" printer configuration file: -o "Queue_Name" -wb (where "Queue_Name" is the name of the queue you want the Macintosh to print to".	
Again, the documentation for the PowerPrint NW will tell you how to set up their drivers. To locate a vendor's address and phone number, use the vendor name as a search string.
