TOPIC -----

Do the SNA•ps Gateway packages include a copy of SNA•ps 3270 GC, and a hardware card for host connections?

DISCUSSION -----

The SNA•ps Gateway doesn't include any application software other than its administration and configuration programs. SNA•ps 3270 GC, or SNA•ps-compatible third-party applications, must be purchased separately for each Macintosh user who will access the SNA•ps Gateway.

SNA•ps Gateway packages don't include a hardware card for host connections. SNA•ps is a family of software-only products that provide Macintosh user access to IBM host systems. The SNA•ps Gateway software runs on Macintosh computers that have an Apple Coax/Twinax Card (for coax cabling), Apple Serial NB Card (for SDLC cabling), or an Apple Token Ring 4/16 NB Card (for Token Ring cabling) installed.
