SNA•ps: Gateway Required for Multiple Sessions

TOPIC -----

We're upgrading from MacDFT to SNA•ps. The current DFT configuration enables multiple CUT sessions at the workstation. When we run the SNA•ps product without the gateway, we see only one session. With the gateway running on the same Macintosh, we see multiple (5) sessions. Can we have multiple CUT sessions without the gateway running? The network card is the Apple Twinax/Coax card.

DISCUSSION -----

To clarify: CUT is one session only. When you were running MacDFT and getting five sessions, you were using DFT services, not CUT.

In the SNA•ps world, if you don't run the gateway, you'll be running in CUT mode, which means you'll be running a single session. If you want multiple sessions, you have to run the gateway.
