## AOCE: Date & Time Control Panel (10/93)

TOPIC
This article describes the function of the Date & Time Control Panel in Apple Open Collaborative Environment (AOCE) and it's importance for proper operation.
DISCUSSION
Many features of AOCE technology rely upon the date and time being correct. PowerTalk includes a new Date & Time control panel for setting the correct date, time and time zone. If any of these are incorrect, users may experience problems with accessing their PowerShare servers. Mail messages will also have the wrong date attached to them.
To set the date and time, open the Date & Time control panel, and check that the information is correct. Set the proper time zone by selecting a city located in the same time zone as the Macintosh computer.
Troubleshooting One common user problem with PowerTalk or PowerShare is getting the date, time, or year wrong. If nothing is working, always check the Date & Time control panel for the correct information, including the correct year. If the system clock has been reset to 1904, AOCE services will not work.
