The PATHWORKS for Macintosh Installer Disk is just like a normal System Software 6.0.7 bootable diskette. The disk has AppleShare Workstation software so you can have access to a VAXshare file server. All the PATHWORKS for Macintosh programs are located at the VAXshare file server. The PATHWORKS Installer Disk will work if your Macintosh is connected to the Digital network through LocalTalk and a router, or through an Apple EtherTalk NB card (EtherTalk software must be installed on this Installer Disk for this use).
