The disk has AppleShare Workstation software so you can have access to a VAXshare file server. All the PATHWORKS for Macintosh programs are located a the VAXshare file server. The PATHWORKS Installer Disk will work if your Macintosh is connected to the Digital network through LocalTalk and a router, or through an Apple EtherTalk NB card (EtherTalk software must be installed on this Installer Disk for this use).
