## Apple IIc: Splitting the Case

**PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:** Using the normal Take-Apart section for splitting the Apple IIc case halves is difficult or nearly impossible to perform on some Apple IIc's that have never been taken apart before.

**BEFORE YOU START:** Familiarize yourself with the Apple IIc Take-Apart procedure (in Apple IIc Technical Procedures). Also, refer to Macintosh Technical Procedures to become familiar with using the Macintosh Take-Apart Tool. (Note: Apple IIc Technical Procedures will be revised to reflect this procedure.)

**CURE:** The Macintosh Take Apart Tool may be used to split the case halves of the Apple IIc. Insert the tool between the front case halves and spread them apart. Once you have the front end split apart try and work your way to the rear of the computer using the normal splitting procedure (see Apple IIc Take-Apart).
