

Macintosh XL: Wrong characters displayed on screen when typing

On occassion, a Macintosh XL running MacWorks Revision B will display the wrong keys when you type on the keyboard: the keyboard seems to function as if the bottom row were shifted to the right by one key. For instance, when you type an "N", an "M" may be displayed on the screen instead. The remedy is simple: merely unplug the keyboard and plug it back in again. Apple Technical Communications
