Power Macintosh: AudioVision Display S-Video Unsupported (2/95)

TOPIC -----

When using the AudioVision 14" Display with my Power Macintosh AV, which S-Video port do I use to input video? The S-Video port on the monitor or the S-Video port on the Power Macintosh AV Display card?

DISCUSSION -----

You should always use the S-Video ports that are on the AV card, since the S-Video port on the AudioVision 14" Display is currently not supported. Page 22 of the AudioVision Display owners guide incorrectly states that S-Video Pass Through is supported.

The same holds true when the AudioVision monitor is connected to a Quadra 660AV or the Quadra 840AV, S-Video is only supported through the card itself and not the monitor.
