What is the maximum number of Macintosh volumes that can be attached to an Apple Workgroup Server (AWS) 95?
DISCUSSION
The Macintosh OS sees all four SCSI buses as one; this makes it unable to distinguish SCSI devices with the same id, but on different SCSI buses. Each HFS volume must have a unique SCSI id between 0 and 6, for a maximum of 7 HFS volumes. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
