DISCUSSION -----

Retrospect, an application for backup and archive of data, comes bundled with any Apple Workgroup Server, which including a DAT drive. In these configurations, Retrospect is supported by the Direct Response Center (DRC).

| Version | Compatible Macintosh Computer |
|--------------------|--|
| Retrospect 2.1a/ux | AWS 95 |
| Retrospect 2.1+ | PCI-based Macintosh computers (not supported by Apple) |
| Retrospect 2.1B | All other Macintosh computers including Workgroup Servers; this version adds support for volumes larger than 2GB |
| Retrospect 3.0 | Works with all Macintosh computers, including ASW 95 with A/UX |

- Retrospect 2.1 or later includes native code for Power Macintosh computers.
- Retrospect 2.1+ Updater

Any Macintosh, or compatible, running System 7.5.2, 7.5.3, or higher requires the Retrospect 2.1+ Updater. This patch will upgrade Retrospect versions 2.1, 2.1i, 2.1A and 2.1Ai to a version that is compatible with these operating systems. Support for these systems is incorporated into Retrospect 3.0.

The following systems ship with System 7.5.2 and require this update:

- * Apple Power Macintosh 7200
- * Apple Power Macintosh 7500
- * Apple Power Macintosh 8500
- * Apple Power Macintosh 9500
- * PowerComputing's PowerWave Line

The Retrospect 2.1+ Updater is required for Retrospect to work under 7.5.3. It can be downloaded from Dantz's world-wide web site at:
