TOPIC -----

There are PAL versions for the Macintosh Display Cards. The label appends  $^{"}A"$  for NTSC, and  $^{"}B"$  for the PAL version.

Is there a visible difference on the card to identify the PAL version?

DISCUSSION -----

The Macintosh Display Card  $8 \cdot 24$  GC (M0122LL/C) has always had PAL capability. The current ROM version is 1.1.

On the other cards, there is no visible difference (8.24 M0507PA/B; 4.8 M0121PA/B). The only change is a ROM revision.

Apple introduced a new ROM for the Macintosh Display Cards 4.8 and 8.24 in July. The card uses sense-pin combinations to determine NTSC or PAL. We ship all new cards with this ROM (version 1.2, part number 341-0868). You can get upgrades for older cards (fee involved; see the August Service Mailing). Copyright 1991 Apple Computer, Inc.
