This article describes the Macintosh Centris 610 computer system, which was replaced by the Quadra 610 computer in October, 1993.

DISCUSSION -----

Overview

The Macintosh Centris 610 is up to two times as fast as the Macintosh IIvx and IIci. It can handle sophisticated graphics and multimedia applications as well as mainstream business programs. And the Macintosh Centris 610 supports up to 68MB of RAM, so you can work with multiple applications simultaneously.

For your convenience, the Centris 610 provides built-in support for all Apple displays. Almost any commonly available display -- monochrome or color, portrait or landscape, 12-inch or 21-inch, RGB or VGA -- works with the Macintosh Centris 610. What's more, the Macintosh Centris 610 is equipped with 512K of on-board video RAM (expandable to 1,024K), so you get more colors than ever from your display without having to purchase an additional video card.

The Macintosh Centris 610 gives you flexibility and choice: you can choose an internal hard disk with storage capacity from 80- to 230MB, opt for on-board Ethernet networking, add an internal CD-ROM drive, install a NuBus or processor-direct card, and even connect two displays. A high-speed SCSI interface lets you add additional peripherals, such as scanners or high-volume storage devices. And AppleTalk networking is built in.

This computer's form factor is designed for horizontal use only.

The Macintosh Centris 610 comes with System Software 7.1 and the System Enabler 040.
