

Color Classic: After Removing Logic Board, Reset Clock (2/93)

TOPIC
Why does my Color Classic ask me to reset the clock after I've removed and replaced the main logic board?
DISCUSSION
The system clock is part of the main logic board. When the logic board is removed, it's disconnected from all power, which resets the system clock.
The main system ASIC (custom integrated circuit) keeps track of whether the logic board has been disconnected, and when it's reconnected system software is reminded to ask you to reset the clock to the appropriate time. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
