Why did Apple select the sheet metal box enclosure for the Macintosh IIvx?
DISCUSSION
There are several advantages to the new sheet metal box over the previously used molded plastic.
<ul> <li>Metal is a natural EMI (Electro-magnetic Interference) barrier. On molded plastic systems, expensive coatings must be used on the inside as a shield.</li> </ul>
• The longevity of a tool used to fabricate a metal cabinet is 3 times as long as that for a plastic mold.
<ul> <li>The roomier size supports many potential configurations. The front and rear bezels are product-specific but the rest of the container is designed to adapt to several different product designs.</li> <li>Copyright 1992, Apple Computer, Inc.</li> </ul>
