The Macintosh IIVx is identical to the Performa 600 except for the following:

- Has a built-in 32K direct-mapped cache.

- Will be distributed through new consumer-channel dealers only.
- Is bundled with the following:
 - Apple Extended Keyboard
 - Application software
 - Simplified interface for new users
 - Special warranty service program
