

Apple Early Language Connections: LC 575 Use CD-ROM 5.0 (9/94)

TOPIC -----

I've had to reinstall the Apple Early Language Connections software on my Macintosh LC 575 computer, and now I cannot get the CD-ROM to recognize any CD ROMS that I put into the computer.

DISCUSSION -----

Version 4.0 of the Apple Early Language Connections CD uses version 4.0.3 of the CD-ROM drivers. The Macintosh LC 575 and other computers that use the AppleCD 300i Plus CD-ROM Drive, require version 5.0 of the drivers. In order to install the Apple Early Language Connections CD on a Macintosh LC 575 computer, follow these steps:

Insert the Apple Early Language Connections CD and reinstall the software.
Restart your Macintosh
Place the Macintosh LC 575 Install Me First CD in the computer.
Use the Custom install option to install version 5.0 of the CD-ROM software.
Restart your Macintosh

Once the new CD-ROM drivers are installed, you can use the CD-ROM drive.

Note: Version 4.1 of the Apple Early Language Connections CD uses version 5.0 of the CD-ROM software, so you don't need to custom install the CD-ROM drivers.
