I would like to make my Macintosh Portable generate color output to a color monitor. Is this possible?

DISCUSSION -----

Aura Systems has a box that plugs into the SCSI port of a Macintosh 512Ke, Macintosh Plus, Macintosh SE, and Macintosh Portable.

ScuzzyGraph II produces high-resolution, color graphics. ScuzzyGraph II can output 16 colors and is QuickDraw-compatible. It gives users screen sizes up to 650 percent larger than the built-in Macintosh SE screen with resolution up to 1,280x1,024 pixels. You can print color on the ImageWriter II or ImageWriter LQ with a color ribbon in place or on an HP PaintJet printer.
