

PowerBook 100 and StyleWriter II: No Grayscale Support (8/93)

TOPIC
I am trying to buy a StyleWriter printer and am considering which model to buy. The StyleWriter II supports GrayShare but I'm sure I read somewhere that the PowerBook 100 has Classic QuickDraw which means it doesn't support grayscale printing.
DISCUSSION
This is true. To enable grayscale printing, you must have Color QuickDraw installed on your hard drive. Color QuickDraw requires at least a 68020 CPU, and a PowerBook 100 has only a 68000 CPU. Therefore, it can only support Classic QuickDraw.
