PowerBook 100 and StyleWriter II: No Grayscale Support (8/93)

TOPIC -----

I am trying to buy a StyleWriter printer and am considering which model to buy. The StyleWriter II supports GrayShare but I'm sure I read somewhere that the PowerBook 100 has Classic QuickDraw -- which means it doesn't support grayscale printing.

DISCUSSION -----

This is true. To enable grayscale printing, you must have Color QuickDraw installed on your hard drive. Color QuickDraw requires at least a 68020 CPU, and a PowerBook 100 has only a 68000 CPU. Therefore, it can only support Classic QuickDraw.
