## PowerBook 165c: Compatibility with Connectix PB Utilities (8/93)

TOPIC -----

My PowerBook 165c is freezing at various times when Connectix PowerBook Utilities (CPU) version 1.0j is active. Is there a fix for this?

DISCUSSION -----

Connectix PowerBook Utilities (CPU) 1.0j has some incompatibilities with the PowerBook 165c. These have been confirmed by Connectix tech support.

The CPU security feature will cause the PowerBook to freeze when the correct password is entered.

The LCD screen saver will cause crashes with bad F-line instructions.

CPU cannot properly manipulate the 165c's backlighting control. This does not cause any crashes.

In order to use CPU software with a PowerBook 165c, go into each saved configuration (all sets for each defined user) and turn the Screen Saver and Security features off individually.

These problems are remedied in Connectix PowerBook Utilities 2.0.
