Duo: If Processor Cycling Slows Applications (8/93)

TOPIC -----

Why do some of my application run extremely slow on my Duo, but not on my desktop Macintosh?

DISCUSSION -----

The Duo has several settings for battery conservation that ration power to different areas of the computer.

The Duo is set to reduce the power supply to the microprocessor when the computer is inactive for a few seconds. Most applications will not be affected significantly by this feature, but if you find certain applications perform unacceptably slowly, turn Processor Cycling off:

- 1) Choose Control Panels from the Apple menu.
- 2) Click the Options menu.
- 3) Click "Don't allow cycling."
