PowerBook Fax/Data Modem: Turning Off Data Compression 3/93

TOPIC -----

I am having a problem using a PowerBook Fax/Data Modem and MacTerminal to connect to our VAX. In order to connect, I need to disable data compression on the modem. I can do this manually, by setting the "&Q" parameter to 1, but when I use the "PowerBook Modem Tool" it resets that parameter to 5, enabling data compression.

Is there a way to modify the modem initialization string for the "PowerBook Modem Tool"?

DISCUSSION -----

One way is to use the Serial Tool to manually configure the modem and dial.

The other way is to use the Apple Modem Tool and select "Custom" modem configuration. This allows you to specify the exact AT commands required.
